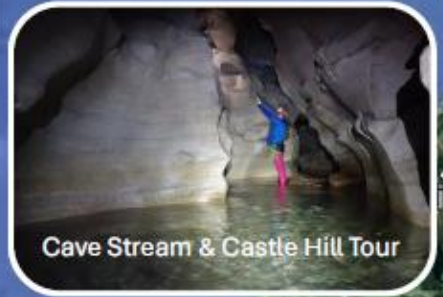

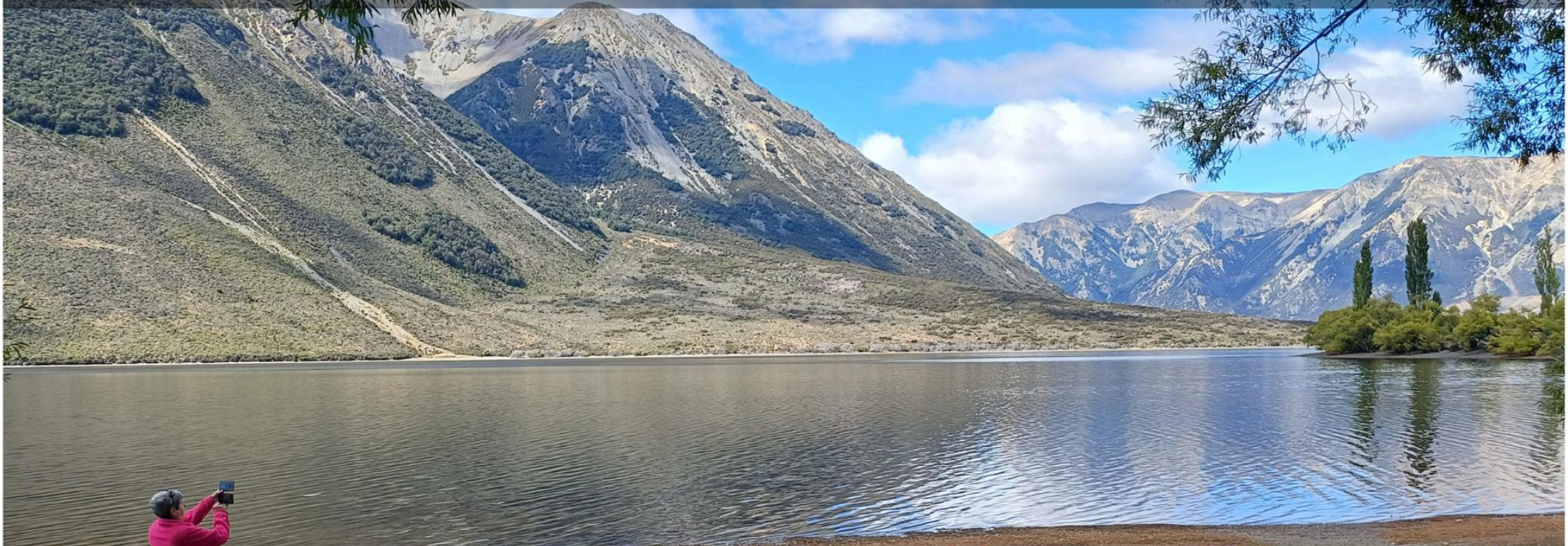

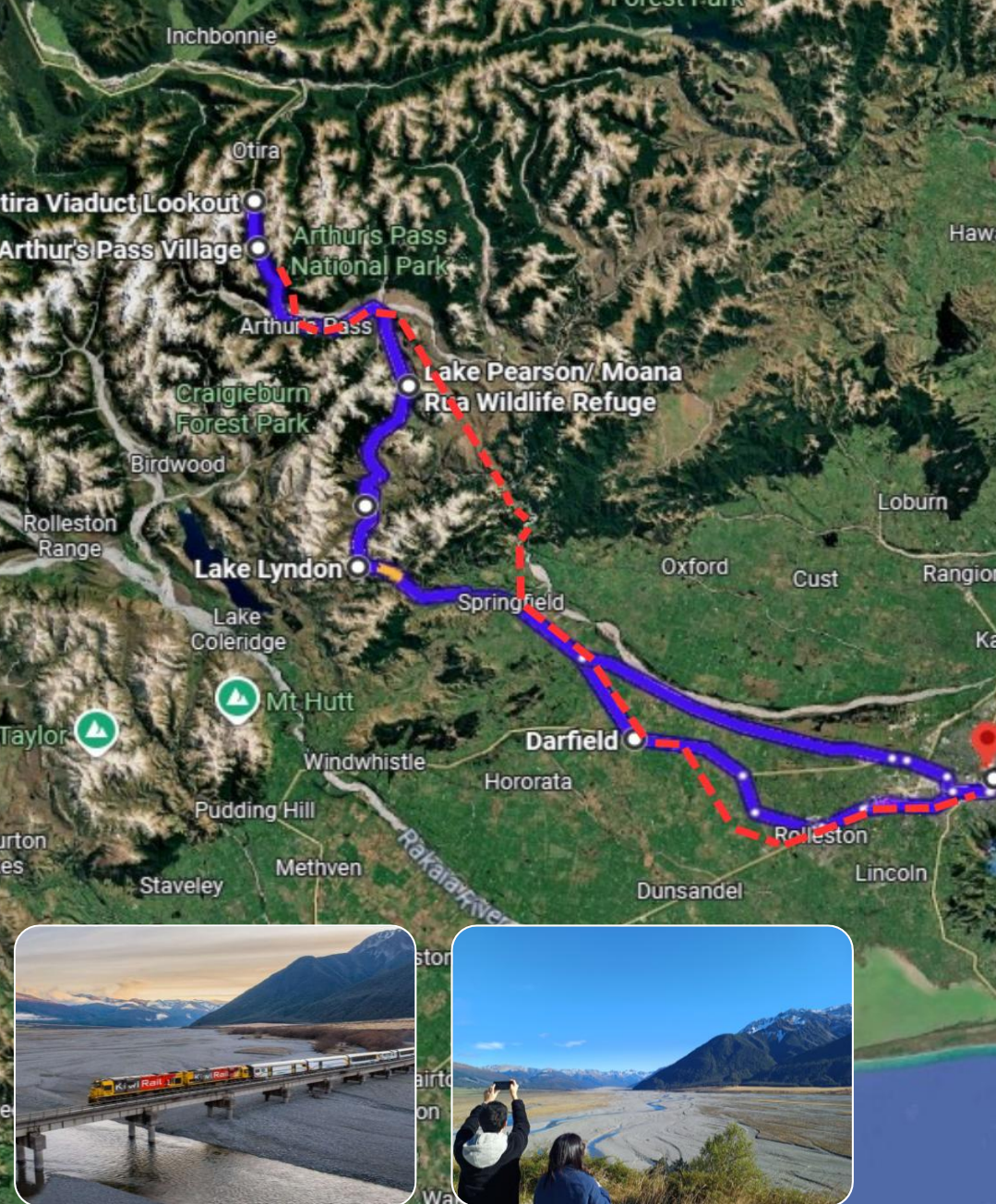
Christchurch to Arthur's Pass Scenic Driving Route

Often referred to as the "Gateway to Christchurch," this working harbour settlement provides an opportunity to soak in its distinctive character before continuing upward into the Port Hills.

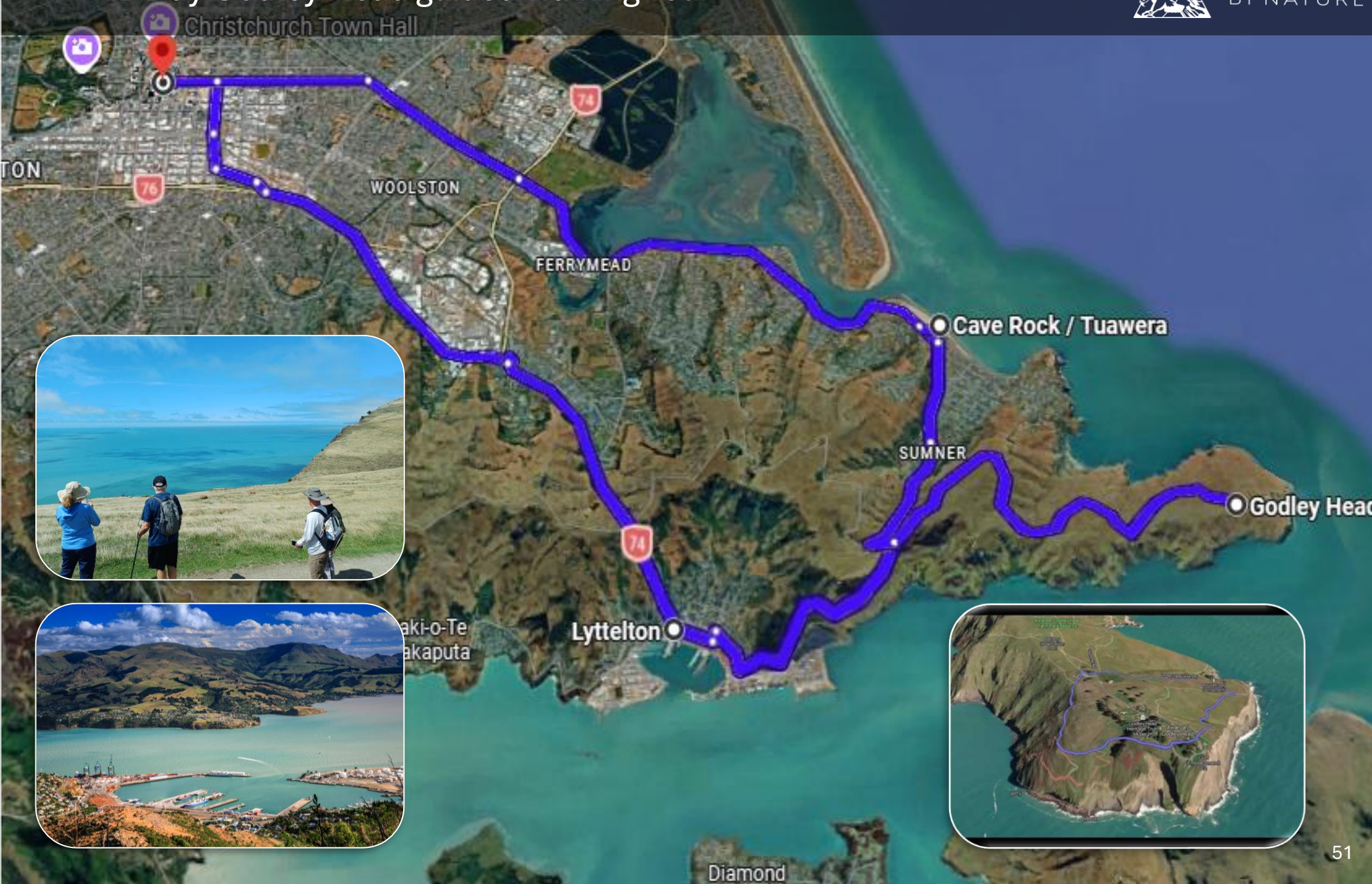
From Lyttelton, the route climbs via Evans Pass Road, where a summit stop offers sweeping views across Lyttelton Harbour and toward the coastal suburb of Sumner. The journey then follows the scenic Summit Road to the Godley Head car park, the starting point for today's walk.

The track forms a loop around the exposed coastal headland, weaving through open terrain with wide-reaching views over the Pacific Ocean and surrounding cliffs. Along the way, you'll encounter preserved WWII structures, including the Godley Head gun battery, where there is time to pause and enjoy morning or afternoon tea in this historic setting. The route also includes a visit to Scott's Cabin, a restored relic from early Antarctic exploration with commanding views across the headland.

After completing the loop, you return to the car park before travelling back to Christchurch, having explored one of the region's most striking coastal headlands.
